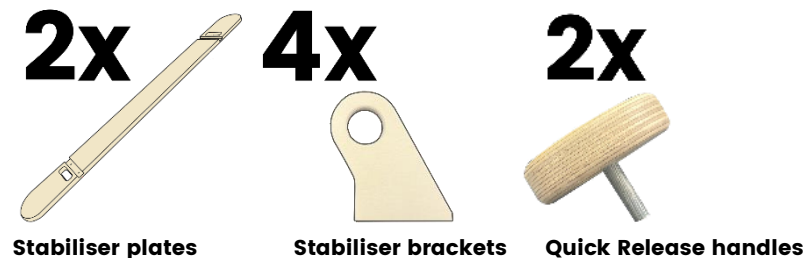
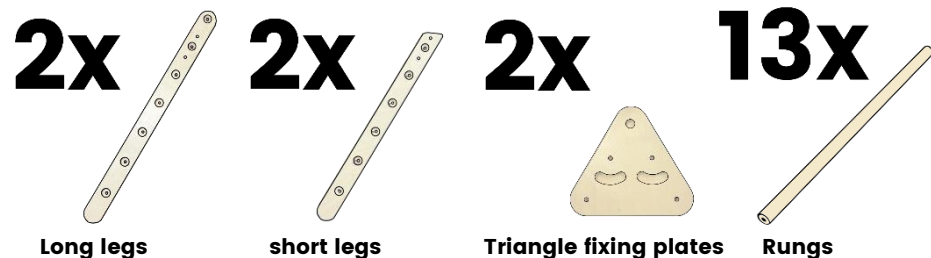


Junior Natural Climbing Triangle

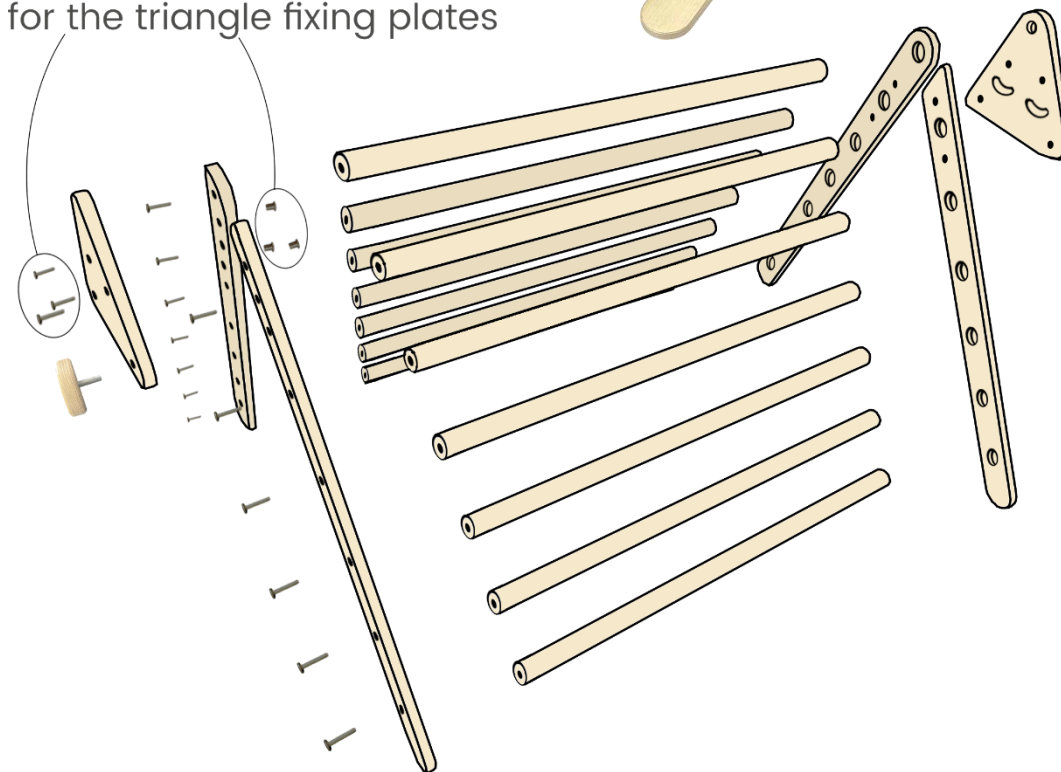


What you will need:

- Competent adult supervision
- PZ2 Pozi head Screwdriver

Assembly instructions:

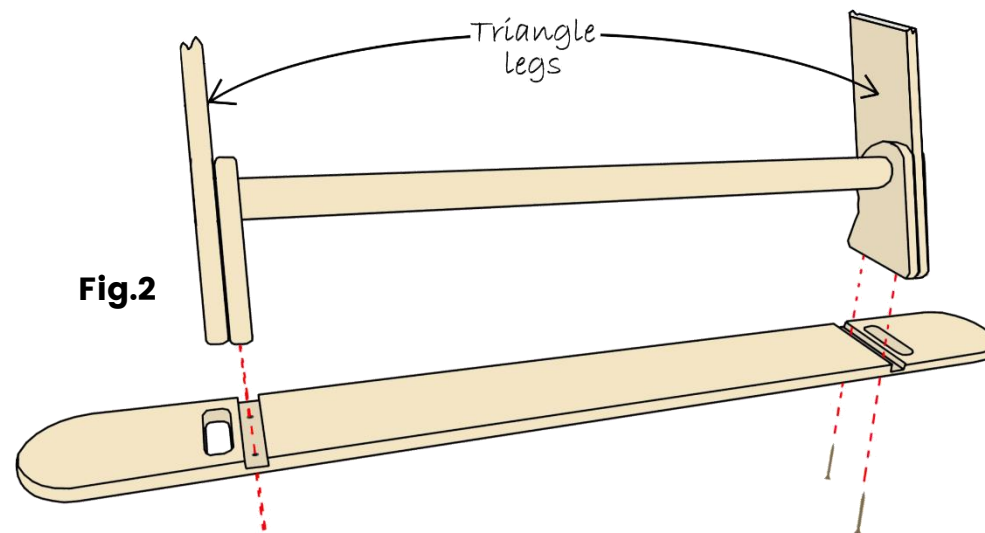
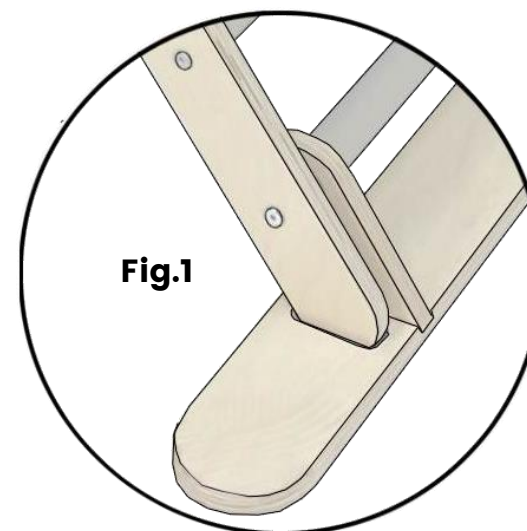
- i) Fit 6 rungs into 1 short leg
- ii) Fasten with 6 male threads into the embedded female threads in the end of each rung using the Allen key
- iii) Slide 2 stabiliser support brackets on to the bottom rung (End without additional holes) ensuring alignment with leg (**fig.1**)
- iv) Fasten the remaining short leg on the other end of the rungs
- v) Repeat steps i,ii, iii & iv with 7 rungs on the long legs
- vi) Insert 6 female threads in the additional holes on the inside of each leg – 2 on the long legs and 1 on each of the short legs (there is already an embedded thread in each of the short legs for the quick release handle)
- vii) Hold up the 2 sides to form the basis of the triangle
- viii) Attach the 2 triangle fixing plates to either side of your formed triangle using 3 male threads in each, leaving the remaining hole for the quick release handles.
- ix) You will find the short leg now pivots. This can be secured in place with the quick release handles
- x) When you have constructed the triangle, turn it over and fix the stabiliser plates to the support brackets as shown (**fig.2**) with the 4 supplied screws. Each screw location has a pre-drilled hole to facilitate the attachment.
